<u>Library reimbursement payments across county lines (Act 420) report:</u> I have received information from all our counties and the information is attached.

<u>2017 County Funding:</u> 2017 county budget requests have been submitted to all counties.

Library Trustee Training: There are several trustee training opportunities coming up in the next couple of months.

Five Wisconsin Trustee Training Week webinars will be held 22 – 26 August. A webinar is a workshop or seminar that is held online; rather than travel to a central location everyone connects from their library, home, or anyplace they can get online. This is the tenth year for Act 420—the law that allows libraries to bill adjacent counties for service to their residents who live in areas without libraries. Now that billing for the 2017 budget year is done I am able to make a report showing which libraries are billing and how much Winnefox counties are being billed.

Twenty-five of our member libraries have chosen to bill adjacent counties, two more than last year. For the most part, billing totals have not changed significantly since last year. In some cases libraries are not billing every county they are entitled to.

- Fond du Lac County Libraries will receive a total of \$63,830, up from \$62,505 last year.
 - \circ <u>Brandon</u> is billing Dodge, Green Lake, and Winnebago counties for \$1,832.
 - <u>Campbellsport</u> is billing Dodge & Sheboygan counties for \$6,292
 - <u>Fond du Lac</u> is billing Calumet, Dodge, Green Lake, Sheboygan, & Winnebago counties for \$ 18,527
 - <u>North Fond du Lac</u> is billing Calumet, Dodge, & Winnebago counties for \$ 1,400
 - o <u>Oakfield</u> is billing Dodge county for \$505
 - <u>Ripon</u> is billing Green Lake & Winnebago counties for \$35,416 Some of these libraries may also be billing Washington County, which does not accept billing sent through the System.
- Green Lake County Libraries will receive a total of \$49,887, down from \$51,716 last year.
 - <u>Berlin</u> is billing Fond du Lac, Marquette, & Winnebago counties for a total of \$20,942. Because the City of Berlin lies partially in Waushara County they will be receiving reimbursement of \$34,710 from them under Act 150, not Act 420, and this amount is not included in the county total above.
 - <u>Green Lake</u> is billing Fond du Lac, Marquette, Waushara, & Winnebago counties for a total of \$5,363
 - <u>Kingston</u> is billing Columbia, Dodge, Fond du Lac, Waushara, & Winnebago counties for \$2,903
 - <u>Markesan</u> is billing Columbia, Dodge, Fond du Lac, & Marquette counties for \$5,644
 - <u>Princeton</u> is billing Fond du Lac, Marquette, Waushara, & Winnebago counties for \$15,035

- Marquette County Libraries will receive a total of \$6,035, down from \$6,687 last year.
 - o <u>Endeavor</u> is billing Columbia County for \$41
 - Montello is billing Columbia, Green Lake & Waushara counties for \$1,739
 - o <u>Neshkoro</u> is billing Green Lake & Waushara counties for \$3,563
 - o <u>Oxford</u> is billing Green Lake & Waushara counties for \$54
 - o <u>Packwaukee</u> is billing Green Lake County for \$212
 - Westfield is billing Waushara county for \$426

Because they receive significant use from Adams County, Oxford has a long-standing agreement by which Adams Co. reimburses them for use by their residents; they expect this to continue in 2017. Because it has a consolidated county library Adams Co. is not required to pay libraries in adjacent counties for use by its residents.

- Waushara County Libraries will receive a total of \$18,060, down from \$19,619 last year.
 - <u>Coloma</u> is billing Marquette County for \$11,745
 - <u>Wautoma</u> is billing Green Lake, Marquette, & Winnebago counties for \$6,213
 - <u>Wild Rose</u> is billing Winnebago County for \$102
- Winnebago County Libraries will receive a total of \$60,232, up from \$44,932last year.
 - o <u>Neenah</u> is billing Calumet Countyfor \$22,497
 - <u>Omro</u> is billing Waushara County for \$1,337
 - <u>Oshkosh</u> is billing Calumet, Fond du Lac, Green Lake, & Waushara Counties for \$35,789
 - Because the City of Menasha lies partially in Calumet County they will be receiving reimbursement of \$62,656 from them under Act 150, not Act 420, and this amount is not included in the county total above.

As some of you know, Winnebago County has a newly-formed municipality: the western part of the Town of Menasha voted this spring to incorporate as the Village of Fox Crossing. As the new village has no library, its incorporation will have no effect on county funding or reimbursement at this time.
