- Continuous reflective effort
- Every point of access and interaction

- Share it with your board
- Share it with your staff
- Review it annually



#### How Do You Know What You Don't Know?

- Adopt a mindset of consideration
- Challenge yourself to see invisible barriers
- Find opportunities to enhance equity
